

**Directions to the Luncheon Reception at the Catholic Student Center, from the Ordination** □  
(Saturday, June 20, 12:30–3:00 p.m.)



Estimated Time: 21 minutes; Estimated Distance: 6.06 miles

- 1: Start out going NORTHEAST on MICHIGAN AVE NE. □  
1.7 mi
- 2: Crossing into MARYLAND, MICHIGAN AVE NE becomes QUEENS CHAPEL RD/ MD-500 E. □  
2.2 mi
- 3: QUEENS CHAPEL RD/ MD-500 E becomes ADELPHI RD. □  
1.4 mi
- 4: Turn RIGHT onto CAMPUS DR. □  
0.4 mi
- 5: At the CIRCLE, turn RIGHT onto MOWATT LN. □  
0.3 mi
- 6: Turn LEFT into MOWATT LANE GARAGE (marked with “ML” signs) west entrance.

**Parking:** It is highly recommended that you park in the Mowatt Lane Garage. Cost: \$2.00/hour. (Parking at the Catholic Student Center is very limited. Street parking is restricted to cars with local permits, and it is regularly patrolled and ticketed. The CSC is not easily reached by Metrorail. The closest station is College Park–U of MD, on the Green Line.)

From the east side of the Mowatt Lane Garage, the Catholic Student Center footbridge is directly across Mowatt Lane.

**Simplest way from the CSC to the Beltway:**

- 1: Start out going SOUTHEAST on MOWATT LN, which becomes GUILFORD DR. □  
0.4 mi
- 2: Turn LEFT onto BALTIMORE AVE/US-1 N. □  
2.9 mi
- 3: Merge onto I-95/ I-495/ CAPITAL BELTWAY.

**Location and parking for the Ordination Mass** □  
(Saturday, June 20, 9:30 a.m.)

The Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception is located at 400 Michigan Avenue NE, on the northeast corner of the intersection of Michigan Avenue with 4th Street/ Harewood Road.

**Parking:** A large, free parking lot is located at the northwest corner of this intersection. Handicap and limited additional parking is available in the small upper lot alongside the Basilica.

**Metro:** Take the Red Line to the Brookland-CUA station. As you exit the station, turn left (west) to go to the Catholic University campus. The National Shrine is about 0.4 mi, along Michigan Avenue or through campus.

The Cathedral of St. Matthew the Apostle is located at 1725 Rhode Island Avenue NW, near the intersection of this street with Connecticut Avenue, M Street, and 18th Street.

**Parking:** On Sunday mornings, some street parking can be found; but allow time to navigate stoplights and one-way streets as you hunt for it. The parking garage attached to the Cathedral is open and costs \$5.00 on Sunday mornings. There are other parking garages nearby.

**Metro:** Take the Red Line to either the Farragut North station (north exit) or the Dupont Circle station (south exit).
